## OUT OF UNIFORM PROCESS

### Student Out of Uniform with a Note

1. Students must bring a note, written and signed by their parents to their Deputy Principal **before school** to obtain a **Yellow Uniform Exemption** note. **Only** Deputy Principals will **issue Yellow Uniform Exemptions**. Roll call teachers **do not issue** these.
2. If a student is out of uniform in roll call **with a note from their parents**, the teacher will mark them present and then send them to their Deputy Principal to obtain a **Yellow Uniform Exemption** note.

### Student Out of Uniform without a Note

1. Where a student is in class / roll call and out of uniform without a note, staff will notify the student that they are being reported for uniform violation and record the student as on the roll by clicking next to the student's name and recording a quick incident which will appear as a negative entry on Sentral.
2. If a student is in the playground and out of uniform without a note, staff will notify the student that they are reported for uniform violation which will be recorded in Sentral.
3. More than 3 violations in a semester will result in an after school detention. Students will be given an additional after school detention for each subsequent violation.
4. Students who are regularly out of uniform without a note are referred to their relevant year deputy principal via Sentral.

### PE/Sport Uniform

During Thursday sport all students must adhere to the correct sport uniform as outlined in the uniform code. Students wearing incorrect sport uniform are to be recorded on-line as uniform violation on the roll in PxP. PE staff will deal with PE/Sport uniform violations during PE lessons.

- **NB** Yr. 12 Students may wear full sports uniform or full school uniform on Thursdays.
