FURTHER REQUIRED INFORMATION

- All documents must be in the name of the enrolling parent/carer and dated within the last 3 months
- Latest school report & NAPLAN to be provided
- Student Identification, Citizenship & Residency requirements:
 - Birth Certificate (acceptable for ID & Citizenship where one or both parents are born in Australia)
 - Birth Certificate (acceptable for ID where both parents are born outside Australia)
 - Students current Australian passport or Citizenship Certificate (acceptable for Citizenship where both parents are born outside Australia excl. NZ)

• Online VEVO information (where both parents are born outside Australia and the student does not hold an Australian passport)
